2019 TAX SEASON IS HERE!

DID YOU KNOW THAT THE STATE OF ALASKA HAS EXEMPTIONS ON PROPERTY TAX

Alaska Statutes sec. 29.45.030

**If you are a Senior Citizen age 65 or older, you can exempt up to \$150,000. 00 on
your primary residence.**

Senior Citizen, Disabled Veteran Exemption Application AS 29.45.030 (e)-(i) Exemption up to \$150,000 of valuation of primary residence. To qualify for tax exemption, property must be applicant's primary residence and permanent place of abode prior to January 1, 2019. Upon initial application, the owner must have been a resident of the State of Alaska for the entire year of 2018. Additionally, in each subsequent year the property must be owned and occupied as the primary residence and permanent place of abode for at least 185 days prior to January 1. Senior Citizen must be 65 on or before December 31, 2018. New applicants must provide proof of age. Disabled Veteran must provide a current letter from the VA (dated within the last year) stating at least a 50% service connected disability.

Disabled Veteran Exemption Information

Disabled Veteran Exemption Information Disabled Veteran" means: a disabled person separated from the military service of the United States under a condition that is not dishonorable, who is a resident of the state, whose disability was incurred or aggravated in the line of duty in the military service of the United States, and whose disability has been rated as 50 percent or more service connected disability by the branch of service in which that person served or by the Veteran's Administration, with an effective date prior to January 1st of the applicable tax year.

Widow/Widower

Upon attaining 60 years of age, the widow/widower, of a previous program participant, may obtain an exemption under the above requirements. Must provide copies of marriage and death certificates.
